

MARSHMALLOW








PLANTER MARSHMALLOW

A piece of street furniture inspired by the soft, evocative shape of a marshmallow, from which it takes its name and organic form.

The MARSHMALLOW planter unfolds around a central core with a subtle, continuous twist, creating a changing perception from every angle and enveloping the user in a fluid and dynamic visual experience.

Its design is a sculptural and functional solution that blends into public spaces with a friendly and recognizable presence.





Available materials and finishes

A. Painted fiberglass

Painted fiberglass with a thickness between 8 and 14 mm.

Gloss White*

Any Colour

*Gelcoat finish

B. Concrete

Element made of high quality architectural concrete / UHPC (Ultra High Performance Concrete) which confers great plasticity and durability.

Fixation

A1. Fiberglass

Metal plate outside the furniture.

Fixing by means of a stainless steel AISI 316 rolled bar or by means of an expansion screw, provided that the floor is compact.

A2. Painted fiberglass

Fixed to the floor using chemicals, epoxy glue, or similar.

B1. Concrete

No anchoring is necessary due to the weight of the piece itself.
