

PLANTER MYWAY


A piece of street furniture born from the dialogue between modularity, simplicity, and compositional freedom. Inspired by Alejandro de la Sota's concept of "simple simplicity" and the structural clarity of Mies van der Rohe's design for the Barcelona Pavilion, Myway translates these principles to the scale of the urban landscape.

Formed by concrete slabs that interlock, the Planter MYWAY allows for almost infinite customization: it can be expanded, lengthened, or reconfigured depending on the space or design intention. In addition, its design allows for play with the colorimetry of concrete, generating rhythms, contrasts, or visual continuity as desired.

Conceived as a natural complement to the Bench MYWAY, this planter articulates a sober but powerful presence in public spaces, integrating nature and architecture from an essential perspective.
