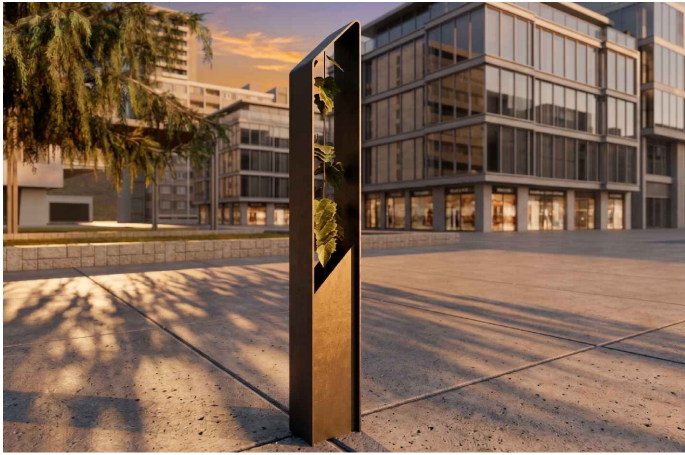

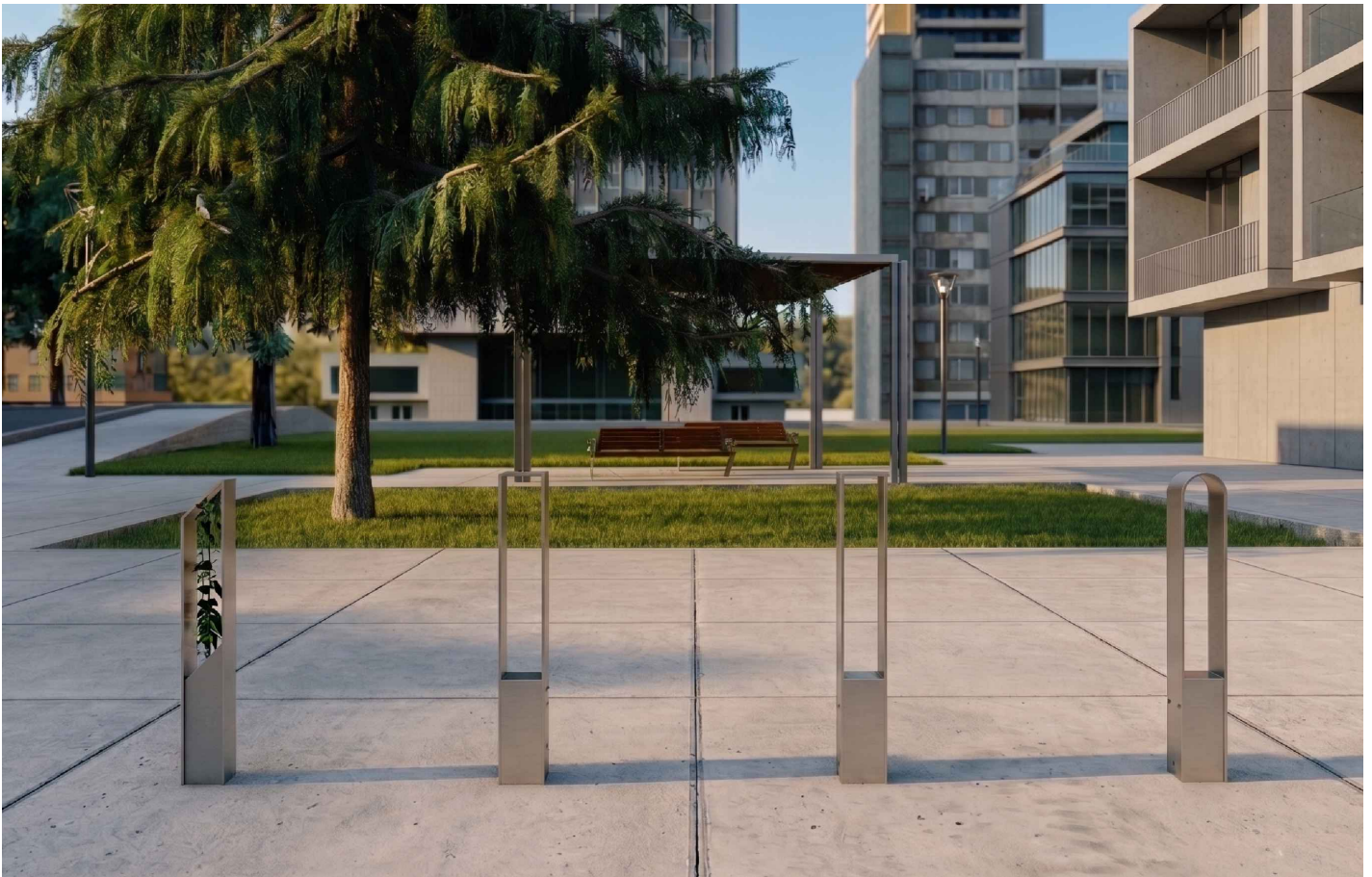


BOLLARD HBIO

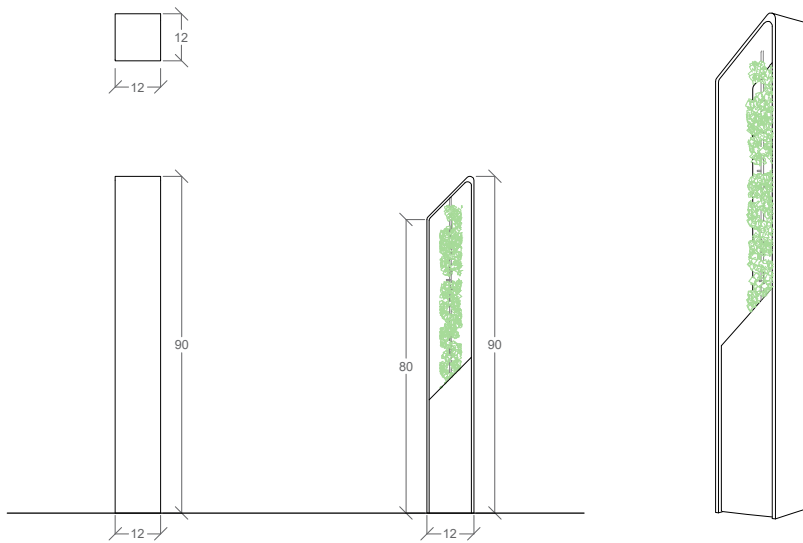

An elegant and understated metal bollard with clean, straight lines, which not only fulfils its function of demarcating, protecting and organising pedestrian traffic, but also adds immense ecological and aesthetic value by helping to green the city. Ideal for seafront promenades, harbours, parks, squares and urban roads.

It is available in a range of heights and indoor planter configurations, allowing for a variety of arrangements depending on the requirements of each space and the type of plants to be included.



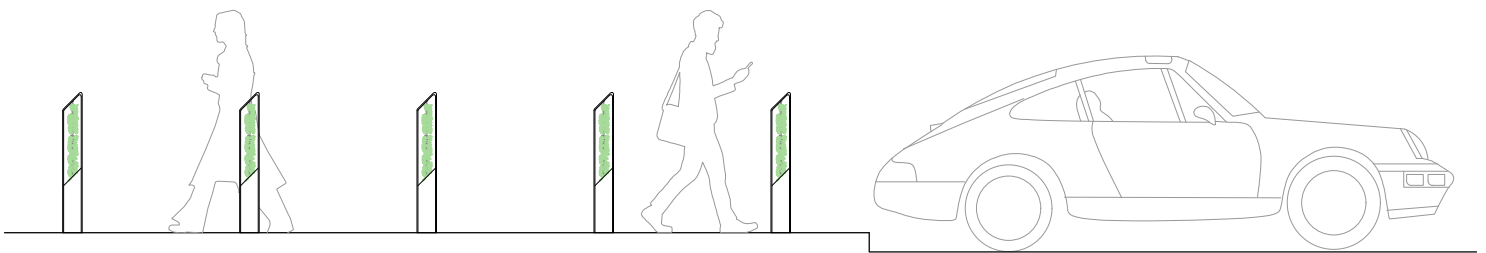
Technical specifications



The purity of its lines and the symbiosis between metal and nature reinforce its commitment to urban sustainability.

A piece of street furniture that is hard-wearing and weather-resistant, designed to last and to foster a comfortable, healthy and socially inclusive environment.

Available materials and finishes

A. Metal structure

The bollard body is made from high-strength metal (steel or aluminium), giving it excellent rigidity, durability and protection against impacts and vandalism.

Finishes: Aluminium, Corten steel (natural rusting), galvanised steel and powder-coated.

B. Green element (Indoor planter)

A removable or fixed indoor module, designed to accommodate vegetation (shrubs, aromatic plants, grasses or small trees), promoting biodiversity and improving air quality.

Fixation

A. Surface anchoring

This unit is bolted directly to the floor using a base plate and stainless steel bolts. Ideal for hard surfaces where quick installation and drainage maintenance are required.

B. Recessed fitting / Chemical anchoring (Optional)

Secured using an anchor tube or a stainless steel threaded rod embedded in the floor. This ensures maximum safety, stability and resistance to being pulled out in areas with heavy footfall or a risk of vandalism.
